Come and join the party! Take an exhibitor space at the Cowes Big Lunch community celebration with your business or artisan craft stall on Northwood House lawn...

...Or bring along your charity or community organisation for free!

General information about the event:

- It's a free to enter "party in the park" style event for residents of the Cowes & East Cowes areas including Gurnard & Northwood, with an expected 2000+ visitors turning out between 11.30am & 6.00pm. Thousands of Big Lunch events are happening throughout the UK in June. The Cowes event is one of the largest and now in its 5th year.
- The celebration is supported by a number of local organisations including the Island Sailing Club, the Royal Yacht Squadron, Northwood House and Cowes Town Council and aims to raise money for several local charities and good causes on the day. The event is also supported by Cowes Business Association.
- The event will have a full afternoon of live music, a fun arena for family activities, fundraising stalls and a village fete style ambience, in keeping with many thousands of other national Big Lunch events.

Terms & conditions:

- If you are a business/art & crafter with a PO31 or PO32 post code you are welcome to take part and take a pitch on the lawn.
- For local businesses it costs only **£30.00 for a single outside pitch** (3m x 3m) or **£50.00 for a double pitch** (6m x 3m), collected when you set up on the day [with all proceeds going to the events fundraising pot.](#)
- Set up on the day on Northwood House Lawn is between 9am and 11am for the 11.30am opening of the event.
- For **charities and community organisations** based in the PO31 or PO32 post code areas you can take a **free 3m x 3m pitch**. The other terms set out here still apply.
- You will need to provide a copy of your current Public Liability Insurance (dated to cover the 2nd June 2019).
- Sorry no catering concessions are available for this event and no food sales are permitted unless for take-home items not for consumption on the site.
- No naked flames or generators are permitted with pitches.
- No power or water is available for pitches.
- Please bring a gazebo for your pitch in case the weather is inclement or to provide shade in hot sunny conditions. The event will go on whatever the weather. We will use inside space of Northwood House if required for the picnic and to relocate stalls if absolutely necessary.
